You should by now have received a letter from Norfolk County Council consulting you on the proposed switch-off of street lights between Midnight and 5am.

Conservative City Councillor Eve Collishaw says:

“It is very important that you have your say on these plans. The switch-off would save money and be better for the environment but many people are concerned about the darkness. The council has said that any road with CCTV, road traffic calming, high traffic flow or where there are issues with crime and anti-social behaviour will not now be affected – but if you have any other feedback we really want to hear it!”
